Good of the Club – .

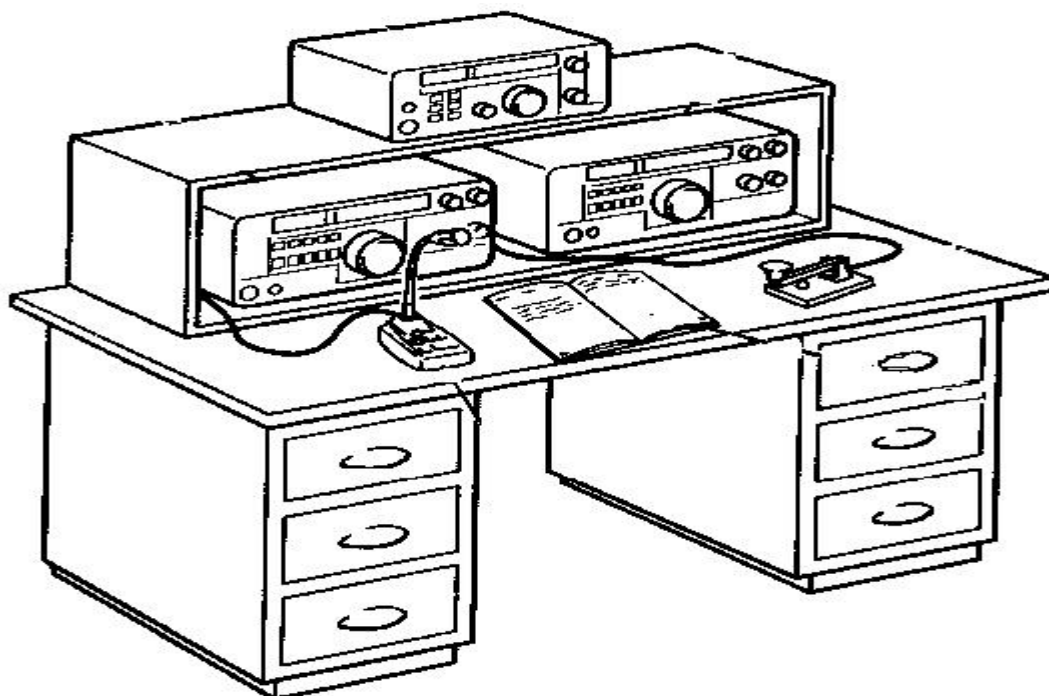
Adjournment – With no further business Terry (WB3BKN) made a motion to adjourn at 2028 hours. Tim (W4NKC) seconded the motion.
