

EXAMPLE NET CONTROL SCRIPT

OVERVIEW

This document is intended to provide Net Control operators for the HRAC Weekly Net on the W3UU repeater with a recommended template to follow when conducting the net. This is not the only version available for use, as you can find as many different versions as there are different clubs. However, this script was adapted from an ARES resource published on the ARRL website.

Please report any issues or concerns to the HRAC Webmaster and appropriate resources will address as needed.

NOTE: When using this document, please substitute your own FCC assigned callsign anywhere you see the example callsign of KD3MAD.

PRE-NET CALL

Radio Check, this is KD3MAD. How copy? Over... (standby for results/comments)

This is KD3MAD, the Harrisburg Radio Amateurs Club weekly net will begin in 5 minutes. All stations please stand by.

STARTING THE NET AND INTRODUCTION

Calling all radio amateurs, calling all radio amateurs, this is KD3MAD starting the Harrisburg Radio Amateurs Club weekly net.

Your Net Control for this evening is KD3MAD, Kilo, Delta, 3, Mike, Alpha, Delta. My name is Mike and I am located in Dauphin, PA. I would like to thank HRAC for the opportunity and responsibility of being tonight's Net Control. This will be a directed net, so please hold comments until recognized by Net Control. (break)

This net meets every Wednesday evening at 1900 hours local on the W3UU repeater on 146.760 MHz, except the second Wednesday of the month which is scheduled for Club Meetings. The purpose of this net is to disseminate information about and relating to amateur radio. Any information or announcements including swap and shop can be presented as long as it is amateur radio related. (break)

As needed, emergency and priority traffic please break in at any time. At this time, I'll standby for any stations with emergency or priority traffic. Any emergency or priority traffic, please call now... (break - wait 5)

ACCEPTING CHECK-INS

As always, we'll begin with check-ins. When checking into this net, please state your full FCC call sign using plain English and standard ITU phonetics, followed by Name, Location and if you have any traffic for this evening's net. Check-ins will be called by Suffix.

Those amateurs that their call sign suffix begins with the letters A through E, please call now (wait for and confirm check-ins)

Those amateurs that their call sign suffix begins with the letters F through J, please call now (wait for and confirm check-ins)

Those amateurs that their call sign suffix begins with the letters K through O, please call now (wait for and confirm check-ins)

Those amateurs that their call sign suffix begins with the letters P through T, please call now (wait for and confirm check-ins)

Those amateurs that their call sign suffix begins with the letters U through Z, please call now (wait for and confirm check-ins)

Thank you for checking-in.

ANNOUNCEMENTS

We'll now continue on with announcements, starting with Club announcements

(review prepared agenda of announcements to be presented to the group)

We'll now move to individual announcements (call each operator, or state having none, we will proceed)

Calling for any late check-ins. If there are late check-ins, please call now (wait for and confirm check-ins)

SWAP AND SHOP

Moving on to Swap and Shop. Anyone wishing to exchange information regarding the purchase, sharing or need for amateur radio related items, please call now... (break - wait 5)

Last call for late check-ins. If so, please call now... (break - wait 5)

LAST CALL AND WRAP UP

Is there anyone with any final comments or announcements for the net? If so, please call now... (break - wait 5)

There being no further comments or announcements for the net, I want to thank everyone for their participation and courtesy to net control, as well as the Harrisburg Radio Amateurs Club for use of the W3UU repeater. This concludes this session of the HRAC Weekly Net at __ __ __ __ hours local on DD MMM YY (i.e. 13 JAN 21).

This repeater and frequency are now returned to regular amateur radio use. Please hang around for additional fellowship and rag chewing as desired. This is KD3MAD signing clear until next time.
