

## **TECHNICIAN CLASS**

- WHO: Anyone interested in preparing for the entry level FCC Technician level amateur radio license test.
- WHAT: One and a half days of instruction, followed by administration of the license test. There is no fee for the class. There is a \$14.00 FCC license testing fee. Please bring a government issued photo ID for testing. Please come with an open mind, pen and paper. A simple calculator and or a Windows PC are useful. Please silence mobile phones. Anyone under 16 years of age must be accompanied by an adult. A study guide will be provided upon registration. Note: The FCC is instituting an application fee, however the date is unknown.
- WHEN: Saturday October 9th (8AM to 4PM) Sunday October 10th (8am to Noon), test immediately follows (1230-3).

- HOW: Please register by providing your name, email and phone number to training@lvsra.org
- WHY: "Ham" Radio is Amateur Radio, FCC Part 91 which is a licensed service. The Technician Class License is restricted to frequencies above 28mhz. There are many hand held and mobile tranceivers available for use in these bands for as low as \$35 for a hand held and \$100 for mobiles. There are many repeaters in the area that extend the range of these radios. Digital mode hand held tranceivers have the ability to communicate with stations all over the world on

only a few watts! A Ham radio license is a great tool for families in times of disaster when land lines and cell phones often are not useable.
